### THE RECIPE CORNER – by Dorothy Shaner

#### Strawberries with Strawberries This recipe is from a 1970s NYT Sunday Magazine article by Craig Claiborne and Pierre Franey. It was oriented around a low-fat/calorie meal. You can make any amount, but this amount serves 4 generously.

4 cups of the nicest strawberries you can find 1/3 cup of sugar (verifine or caster sugar is best)

Measure out 2 cups of the berries, using the "least nice" ones – perhaps not totally ripe or with soft spots. Hull these, halve or quarter depending on size and combine in Cuisinart with 1/3 cup of sugar to make a thick sauce.

Refrigerate separately the berry sauce and the other two cups of berries, not yet hulled.

A couple of hours before serving, hull remaining berries and combine with sauce. Re-chill.

Serve with mint in a pretty glass bowl.

The leftover sauce keeps and you can add more berries to it for family.

Let me know if you like this. If so, I have another (more caloric) strawberry recipe.
