We will meet at the United Church parking lot at 9am (9:15 at the White Rock "Y"), drive to Puye Cliffs on the Santa Clara Pueblo and arrive at10am for a two-hour tour of the Cliffside dwellings, the mesa-top ruins, and the Harvey House. Yes, Fred Harvey built a bed & breakfast in Santa Clara Canyon! Puye Cliffs was home to more than a thousand Pueblo Indians who lived, farmed and hunted there from the 900's to 1580 A.D. and were the ancestors of today's Santa Clara people.
